At this year's PaperCon in April, two leaders from Longview Fibre Paper and Packaging, Longview, Wash., shared the story of their company's transformation from the time it was acquired by Brookfield Asset Management in 2007 until today. During that time, Longview, while maintaining its steadfast focus on the manufacture of kraft paper products, has essentially become a new company culturally, operationally, and financially.

Longview Fibre Paper and Packaging produces lightweight, high-performance multiwall and complementary specialty kraft papers for an established domestic and global customer base. The company also produces containerboard and corrugated boxes. Longview operates a pulp and paper mill at Longview, Wash., and a network of seven converting plants in the western U.S.
